- Requirements for **traceability and mass balance**
- Requirements for **greenhouse gas calculations**.

There will be a **special focus** of the Training on the:

- Certification of **waste-based feedstock, biofuels and supply chains** (in particular **UCO**)
- **Export opportunities** for waste and residue-based biofuels to **EU** and the **USA**
- Upcoming **legislative and market developments**

The participation in the ISCC EU and PLUS Basic Training is a mandatory requirement for all auditors before they can conduct audits under ISCC. Participation is also recommended to ISCC System Users and companies preparing for ISCC certification.
