Challenges arise, but also potential for new markets and greener companies that commit to climate action

Why do we need certification?

• To guarantee:

- Sustainability and no-deforestation on farms and plantations
- Raw material identity (e.g. waste and residue vs. virgin)
- Traceability
- Correct volumes and conversion factors throughout entire value chain
- Correct use of mass balance calculations and attribution approaches
- Appropriate carbon intensity calculations


Certification allows credible use of:

- Claims towards customers, end consumers and other stakeholders
- On-product ISCC logos by brand owners





Under ISCC PLUS these raw material categories can be covered










ISCC certification applies for the entire supply chain






ISCC certifies different chain-of-custody approaches and creates transparency on the approach chosen. Chemical and mechanical recycling is covered

ISCC certificates increase annually since several years





