

### **Policy context**

European Green Deal: the EU to be climate
 neutral in 2050



- EU intermediate target: reduce emissions by at least **55% by 2030** (vs 1990 levels)
- ReFuelEU Aviation part of the 'Fit for 55' package, with focus on aviation and SAF
- Contributing also to ICAO LTAG:







### **Objectives of ReFuelEU Aviation**





Foster the ramp-up of SAF supply in the EU and ensure availability of SAF to decarbonise aviation

Guarantee a **level playing field in aviation** through a
harmonised EU approach



### Scope and obligations of the Regulation



#### **Aviation fuel suppliers**

Who

All aviation fuel suppliers supplying to Union airports



#### **Union airports**

≥ 800 000 passengers

≥ 100 000 tonnes freight

Opt-in for airports below threshold, and those in outermost regions



#### **Aircraft operators**

> 500 passengers flights

> 52 all-cargo flights

Opt-in for other commercial flights and for noncommercial flights

What

a) to supply increasing amounts of SAF at each Union airport

b) with flexibility 2025-34

to facilitate access to SAF

to uplift aviation fuels at Union airports without 'tankering' practices



Ambitious EU-wide binding shares and realistic ramp-up 2025-2050









### **Eligible aviation fuels**



SAF sustainability framework in accordance with Renewable Energy Directive (EU) 2018/2001







### **Supporting measures**

Fostering cross-sectoral collaboration and matchmaking

(RLCF: Renewable and Low-Carbon Fuels Value Chain Industrial Alliance) Strengthening global collaboration at ICAO (LTAG, CORSIA, ACT-SAF)

Accelerating qualification of new SAF pathways and permitting of new plants

(EU SAF Clearing House, Net-Zero Industry Act)

Financing to narrow down the price gap between SAF and fossils

(SAF Allowances and Emissions Trading System, energy taxation) Financing to de-risk SAF production at all technology maturity stages

(Horizon Europe, Innovation Fund, InvestEU)

Increasing transparency on SAF uptake and sustainable investments

(EU taxonomy, environmental label)
