- 18 MMT capacity



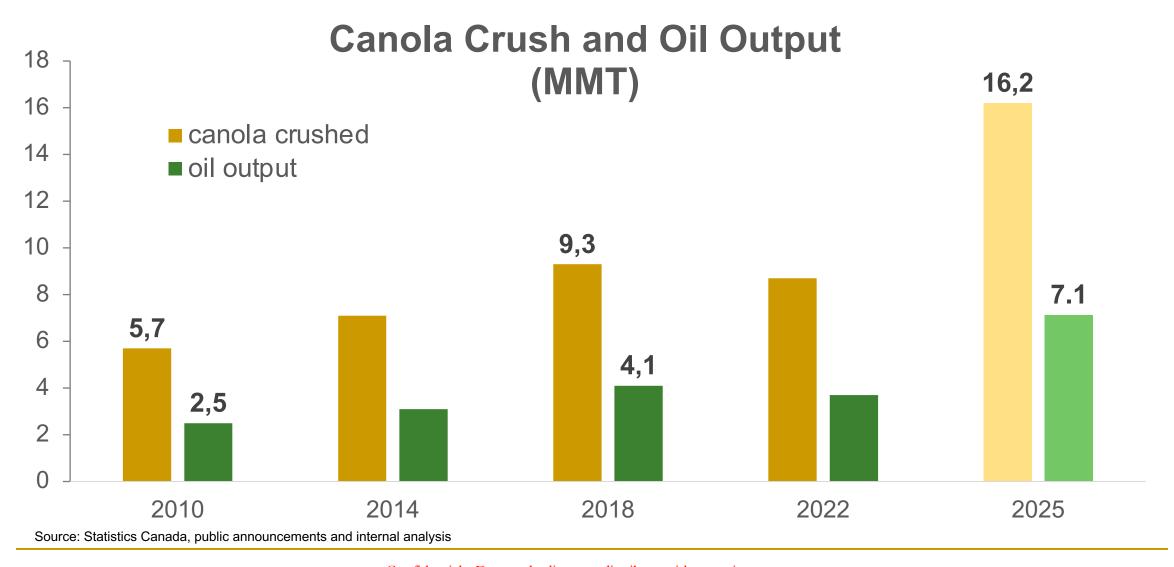

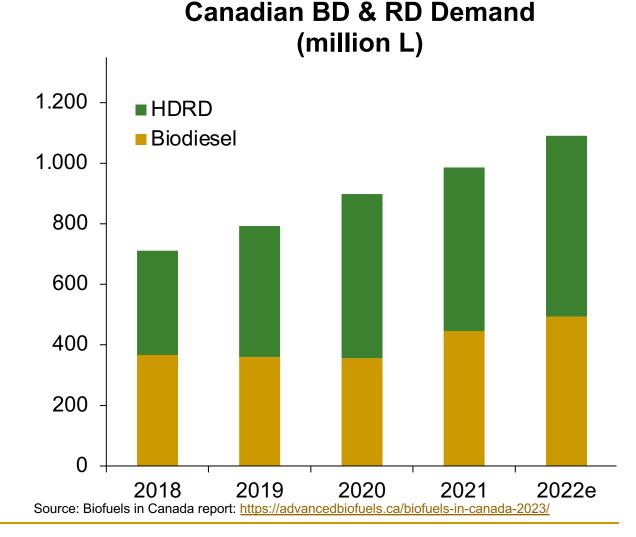
Growth outlook for canola processing



Low Carbon Fuel Markets in North America



- Implementation of CFR in July 2023.
 - CI reduction of 15 % by 2030.
 - CDN agriculture deemed sustainable.
- Incentives to compete with IRA.
 - Support for domestic prod'n needed.
- Provincial programs underpin demand.
 - BC LCFS 30 % CI stringency
 - QC 10 % blending mandate by 2030

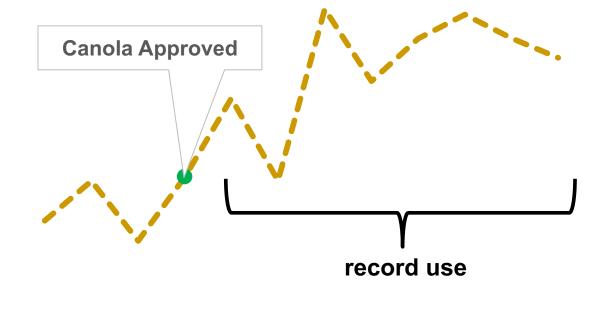

- EPA approval a boon for canola.
 - Future updates to RFS RVO critical.
- IRA tax credits supports future growth.
 - Clarity on CI component important.
- State LCFS programs buoy demand.
 - Regulatory update in CA soon.
 - Positive momentum in OR and WA.
 - New state programs possible (MN, NY, NM, etc.)

- SAF a huge potential market for canola.
- Demand <u>and</u> supply drivers important.
- CORSIA a helpful backstop for demand.
 - Canola fits with ISCC certification.
 - CI scoring needs improvement.
- NA market drivers are evolving.
 - U.S. and state tax credits.
 - CI obligation in CA.
 - Mandate and CI obligation in BC.
